- Applicant must be involved in or plan to be involved in the management of natural resources, specifically fish, wildlife, forest, soil or water.
- Applicants must already have earned at least 60 hours of college credit.

### **Please make sure you have submitted the following items:**

- Applicants must provide three letters of recommendation. References may be teachers, employers or persons who are personally acquainted with you but not related to you. Letters should accompany the application.
- Applicant must include a copy of his/her high school transcript and his/her college/university transcript
- Applicant must list community and school activities
- Applicant should give a profile of their work experience, if applicable.
- Applicant should include a statement of need.
- Applicants must be able to provide a copy of the letter of acceptance to the college or university they are or will be attending.

### **The application must be complete and accurate**

- Applications and letters of recommendation must be received by January 31.
